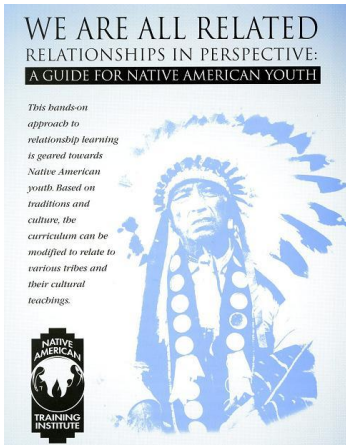

This hands-on youth development approach to relationship learning is geared towards Native American youth. Based on traditions and culture, the curriculum can be modified to relate to various tribes and their cultural teachings.

“We Are All Related” (WAAR) provides a forum for issues of relationships and gives a voice to youth so they can determine what they think about relationships, allowing them to make *informed* decisions. The curriculum is very respectful to youth as it promotes their ideas and thinking. The four lessons are appropriate for a retreat or classroom setting. It is complete in itself or as a preface to another unit in relationships, alcohol and drug issues, HIV-AIDS prevention and other related health issues. This training will teach you how to use the curriculum through a “Train the Trainers” perspective and is interactive, activity-based and fun to use!
